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OFSTED

As everyone is aware the school underwent an inspection from Ofsted this week. We received a call from Ofsted on Monday 23rd September 2019 informing us that Glade Primary will be inspected under a Section 8 on the new Ofsted Inspection Framework. Following on from a 90 minutes phone call with Mrs. Hussain, Christ Birtles, the Lead Inspector, confirmed the three curriculum areas that they call 'Deep dives'. These were Reading, Maths and History. The Lead Inspector and HMI were impressed by the warmth of the welcome they received and thanked staff, pupils, Governors and parents.

We are unable to share the outcome of the two-days inspection until the letter from the Lead Inspector is published. We understand this may take up to 25 days due to Ofsted's quality assurance procedures.

In the meantime on behalf of the Governing Body, we would like to thank all the parents who completed the parentview survey and to all the staff and children who were involved in this process. Everyone involved has represented and presented our school in an extremely professional and friendly manner and as ever the children of Glade Primary have been a great credit to us all.

We look forwards to sharing the letter as soon as it arrives.
