Where does my child need to be at the end of Reception?

Reading and Writing



Reading

- We would like the children to be on at least the yellow books (stage 3 BCP) by the end of reception.
- Hearing initial, middle and end sounds and blending words back together.

Writing

- Writing simple sentences independently.
- Thinking of their own sentence to write.
- Including finger spaces, sentences, full stops and capital letters.
- To be able to read their work back.
- Have an understanding of CVC words and rhyming strings.
- Correct letter formation.

Book bags in every day please!

Phonics

- Children will continue to work in groups for phonics sessions.
- Groups range from covering single sounds,
 Digraphs, Trigraphs, CVC words, segmenting,
 blending and letter formation.
- HFW's
- We will be sending out individual sounds that your children need to practice rather than weekly sounds.

Maths

- Counting, ordering and recognising numbers to 20
- More and fewer
- Addition and subtraction
- Doubling and halving
- Odd and evens
- Subitising
- 2D and 3D shapes
- Counting in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's up to 50 (forwards and backwards)

Curriculum Plan

- UW Looking at different environments, looking after our planet and the world around us
- Art Still life, watercolours, using different materials, adding details to their drawings.
- P.E. -Team games & apparatus
- R.E. Different celebrations
