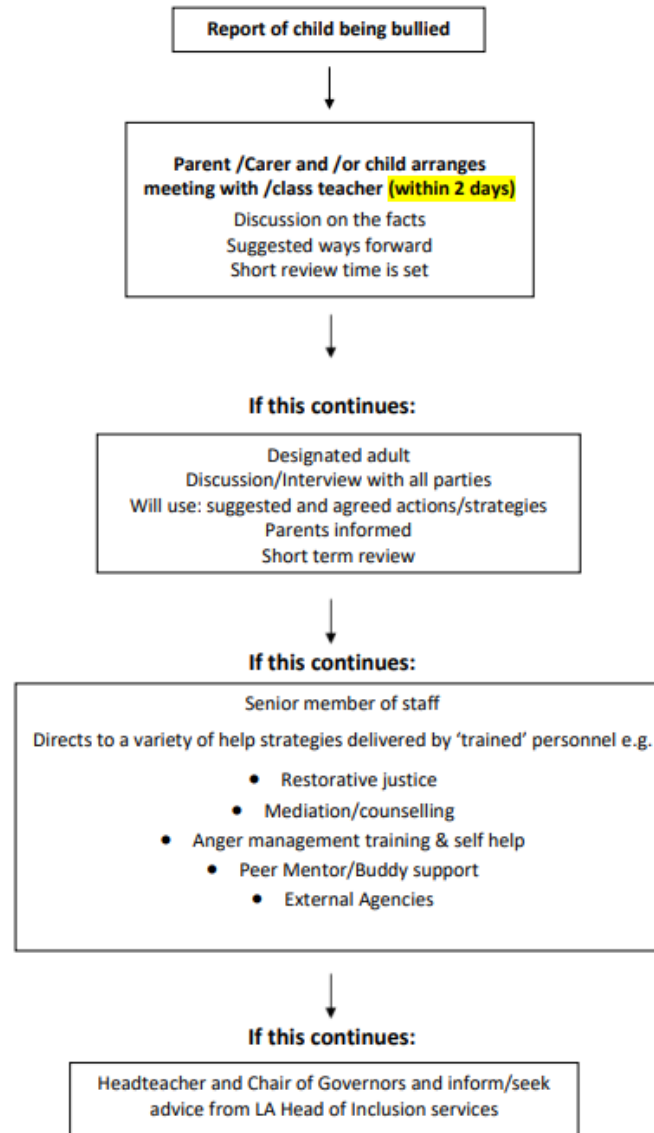
Please ensure that no NUTS are sent into school. This includes any treats that are sent in for birthdays.
