School Dinner Arrears

At present our school dinner arrears have reached an unacceptable level of nearly £2000. As from Monday 3rd February any child who is not up to date with their dinner money will no longer be given a school dinner. If your child is in arrears for their school dinners and you are unable to clear the debt by the 3rd February please ensure you provide a packed lunch until the debt has been paid.

Please remember to provide your child with a bottle of water each day as hydration is essential for their well being.

On Wednesday 22nd January the School Councillors met with Mrs Hussain, Mrs Rose, the school cook, the Area Manager and Food Ambassador from ISS (our catering company) to explore their thoughts about school meals. During the meeting, an over-whelming number of pupils shared what they enjoy about their school meals and what food they look forward to. We then encouraged the children to think of ways their lunch time experience can be improved. It was a very productive meeting as children learnt about the nutritional content of the food they eat and what is allowed to be part of school meals and what is not allowed. The team at ISS have taken back the feedback from children and will continue to work with us. The team also met with two parent representatives and have suggested a food tasting session, where parents can come in and try a sample of the food available on our school menu.
