Reading Rocket Relunched!



In order to encourage a love of books and reading at home we will be relaunching our 'Reading Rocket' scheme. Every time a child reads at home and a comment and signature are written in their diary, they will get 1 reading point.

Please note that 1 point is given for each reading session rather than each book read.

25 points earns a bronze certificate, 50 a silver, 75 a gold and at 100 points, children will receive a super reader certificate and a book. Children may read a story book, their staged reading book (in Years 1 and 2) or their e-book (coming soon for Reception and Year 1 children only).

Achievements will be recorded on the class Reading Rocket and all certificates awarded will be listed in the weekly newsletter.

National Poetry Day

Last week, we celebrated National Poetry Day. As this year's theme was 'choices,' we decided to link this to our campaign as a school to create awareness on the negative effects that our choices may have on the environment.

Our children really enjoyed an immersive experience which consisted of listening to, performing and writing poetry.
