<b>Year 1</b>	<b>National Curriculum requirements:</b> letter, capital letter, word, singular, plural, sentence, punctuation, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark, suffix, prefix, verbs, adjectives, clause, pronoun
<b>Year 2</b>	<b>National Curriculum requirements:</b> noun, noun phrase, statement, question, exclamation, command, compound, suffix, adjective, adverb, verb, tense (past, present) apostrophe, comma, subordination (using when, if, that, because) and co-ordination (using or, and, but), expanded noun phrases
<b>Year 3</b>	<b>National Curriculum requirements:</b> preposition, conjunction, word family, prefix, clause, subordinate clause, direct speech, consonant, consonant letter, vowel, vowel letter, inverted commas, present perfect, forms a or an, punctuate
<b>Year 4</b>	<b>National Curriculum requirements:</b> determiner, pronoun, possessive pronoun, adverbial, apostrophes, fronted adverbials, plural possession, cohesion, verb inflections
<b>Year 5</b>	<b>National Curriculum requirements:</b> modal verb, relative pronoun, relative clause, parenthesis, bracket, dash, cohesion, ambiguity, adverbials, verb prefixes suffix
<b>Year 6</b>	<b>National Curriculum requirements:</b> subject, object, active, passive, synonym, antonym, ellipsis, hyphen, colon, semi-colon, bullet points, independent clauses, cohesive devices, subjunctive form, formal register, informal register
