Key worker provision

We are now at full capacity with our three different bubbles of key worker children. Each bubble has a teacher and an LSA. Currently, there is no more room for any more key worker children. If the existing children no longer need the provision, we will let you know of any available space. The teachers leading the Key Worker bubbles are Mrs Craggs, Miss Reeves, Mrs Hussain, Mrs Graham, Mrs Kotecha and Mrs Alvi.

Key Worker children are expected to arrive at school for 8.45am and finish at 3.30pm Monday to Friday using the main school entrance on Atherton Road.



Year 1

It has been a great start to the Year 1 bubble where children have settled in really well with Mrs Miah and Mrs Seth. Currently, we have only one Year 1 bubble as the number of parents wishing to send their children to school was very low.

Next week, there will be an additional bubble with Ms Rana, Mrs Stockings and Mrs Brown. Year 1 children are expected to arrive at school for 9am and finish at 3pm Monday to Thursday using the main school entrance on Atherton Road.
