We raised **£152.22** for this worthy cause. This donation will help to fund research into genetic disabilities.

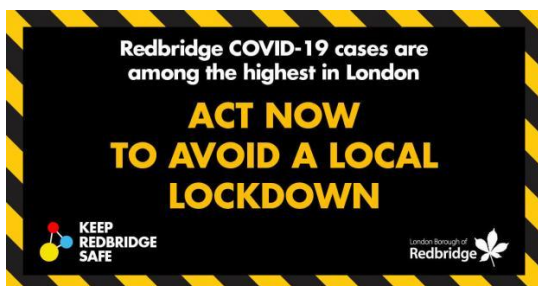
