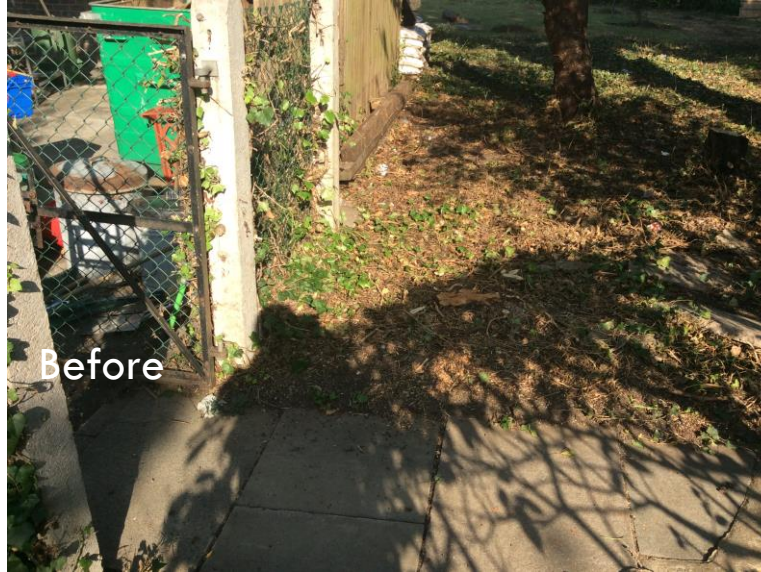




# OUTDOOR AREA DEVELOPMENTS.

# YEAR 5 SCULPTURE WORKSHOP



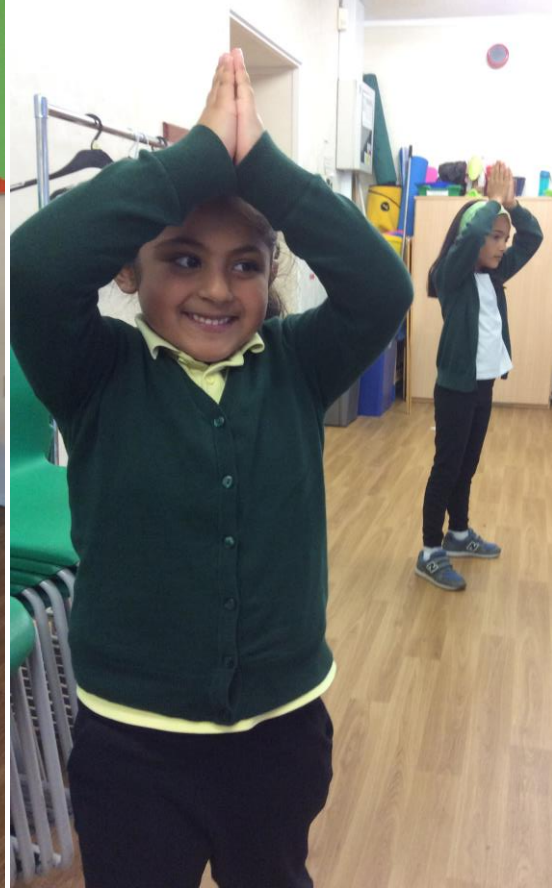
**Children in year 5 have had wire sculpture workshops with Reza. They have learnt many new techniques and have produced some wonderful pieces of art.**

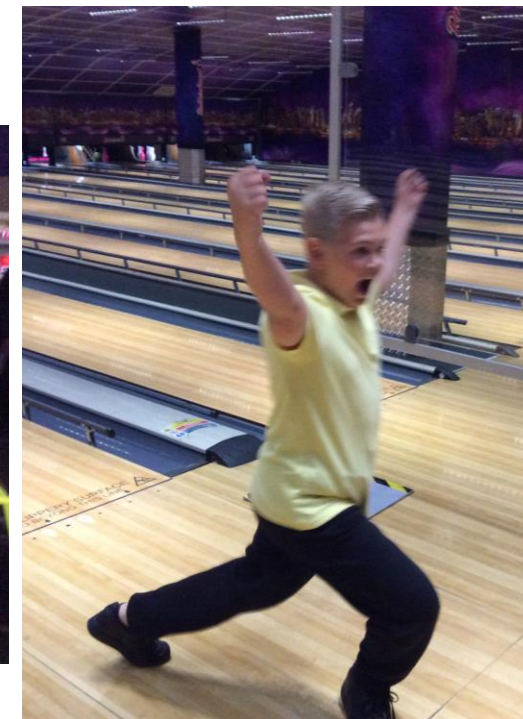




# YEAR 6 —TRIPS
