FAMILY GUIDANCE AS CHILDREN DEVELOP

Outdoor Learning- Year 2

As part of our English lessons, we are analysing the book 'The Winter's Child.' The children went outside to use their senses to be able to imagine what it would feel like to be on the cover of the book.

In Science we are learning about 'Animals and their habitats.' Children talked about the elements needed in a perfect habitat and sorted a range of animals according to where they would prefer to live. We also used some real habitats found in our school grounds: the pond area and the forest. We then created some habitats in our garden area: a desert and the Polar Regions.

During our Art lessons, we have been learning about different types of lines and using them to sketch winter trees. We went out into the playground to look at the trees, think about what lines might need to be used to draw them and then practised sketching skills.



Iliad Project -Year 4

This term, children in Year 4 are learning about Homer's 'The Iliad,' the tale of the Trojan War. Jonny Walker's whole-class retelling draws out the drama, rivalry and philosophy, and it is shared with pupils in a way that is memorable, entertaining and age-appropriate.



In this week's lesson, children learnt that Zeus heard a prophecy that the child of a water goddess would be very powerful - he tried to limit the power by making her marry a mortal. But at the wedding, an uninvited guest brought a hideous gift - the Apple of Discord.

Zeus and Paris, the Prince of Troy, needed to decide what was most important to them - power, wisdom or beauty?

Children had a great time exploring what matters most of all in their life- strength, knowledge or pleasure?
